Re: AAUP 9.2.7.2 Tuition Scholarship Program – Limited, specific exceptions

An ad hoc committee of AAUP and administrators has reviewed currently available internal funding opportunities in order to identify University-funded scholarships and grants that may be considered exceptions for the purposes of 9.2.7.2 of the Master Agreement.

9.2.7.2 Those who participate in the Tuition Scholarship Program are not eligible to receive additional University-funded scholarships or grants, although there may be limited, specific exceptions. Contact the Financial Aid Office for questions regarding receipt of additional University-funded scholarships or grants.

For purposes of this provision, University-funded means any funds deposited at the University where the University makes the decision concerning the recipient.

The committee recommends those who participate in the Tuition Scholarship Program be eligible to receive the following scholarships and grants, which support scholarly activity and/or academic-related travel.

Additional University-funded grants or scholarships for scholarly activity and/or travel may be considered for the exception. An ad hoc committee of AAUP and administration may be formed no more than once per semester to consider grants or scholarships that are brought to either AAUP or Academic Affairs. Scholarships or grants will only be considered for the exception if they are University-funded, support scholarly activity and/or academic-related travel, and are not used for tuition. The ad hoc committee will submit recommendations to the PVPAA for final approval.
